

Deadline for Entry: by midnight on February 29, 2024

<u>Guideline</u>

Star 105.3, 107.9 The Beat, and Hot 102.7 are proud to honor Black History Month with the 18th Annual Scholarship Essay contest. This contest is open to all area high school seniors. Employees of Black Crow Media, affiliated entities, participating sponsors/promotional partners, other radio station employees in the Black Crow Media Group, and the members of their immediate families are ineligible to participate or win.

This year's topic is as follows:

"Who is your generation's version of Black History in the making? How are they impactful today and what do you think they will do for the world's future?" Please include citations from your research sources.

All essays must be typed and double-spaced with a minimum of 500 words, but not exceeding 1,000 words. The word count should not include your source citation page.Video entries must be 3-5 minutes in length. Please do not use your name or appear on the video itself. You may narrate the audio, but use pictures or graphics for the video. You must include a graphic of the sources you used, much like the citation page for the written page. No hand-written or late entries will be accepted.

DO NOT PUT YOUR NAME OR IDENTIFYING IMAGE ON THE ENTRY ITSELF.

Entries must be uploaded through the websites of Star 105.3, 107.9 The Beat, Hot 102.7, no later than February 29, 2024 at midnight. Website addresses are as follows: mystar1053.com, thebeat1079.com, and myhot1027.com. Written entries can also be hand-delivered, stapled to the completed entry form, to the offices of Black Crow Media, 1711 Ellis Drive, Valdosta, Ga 31601 before 3 pm, Thursday, February 29, 2024.

Essays will be judged on a blind basis (no names attached) by an independent, objective committee of judges using a predetermined set of criteria. Judging will be completed by March 10, 2024 and finalists will be notified March 11, 2024. Placements will be announced during a reception at a location to be determined on Friday, March 15, 2024 at 3pm, where the winner will be announced.
